

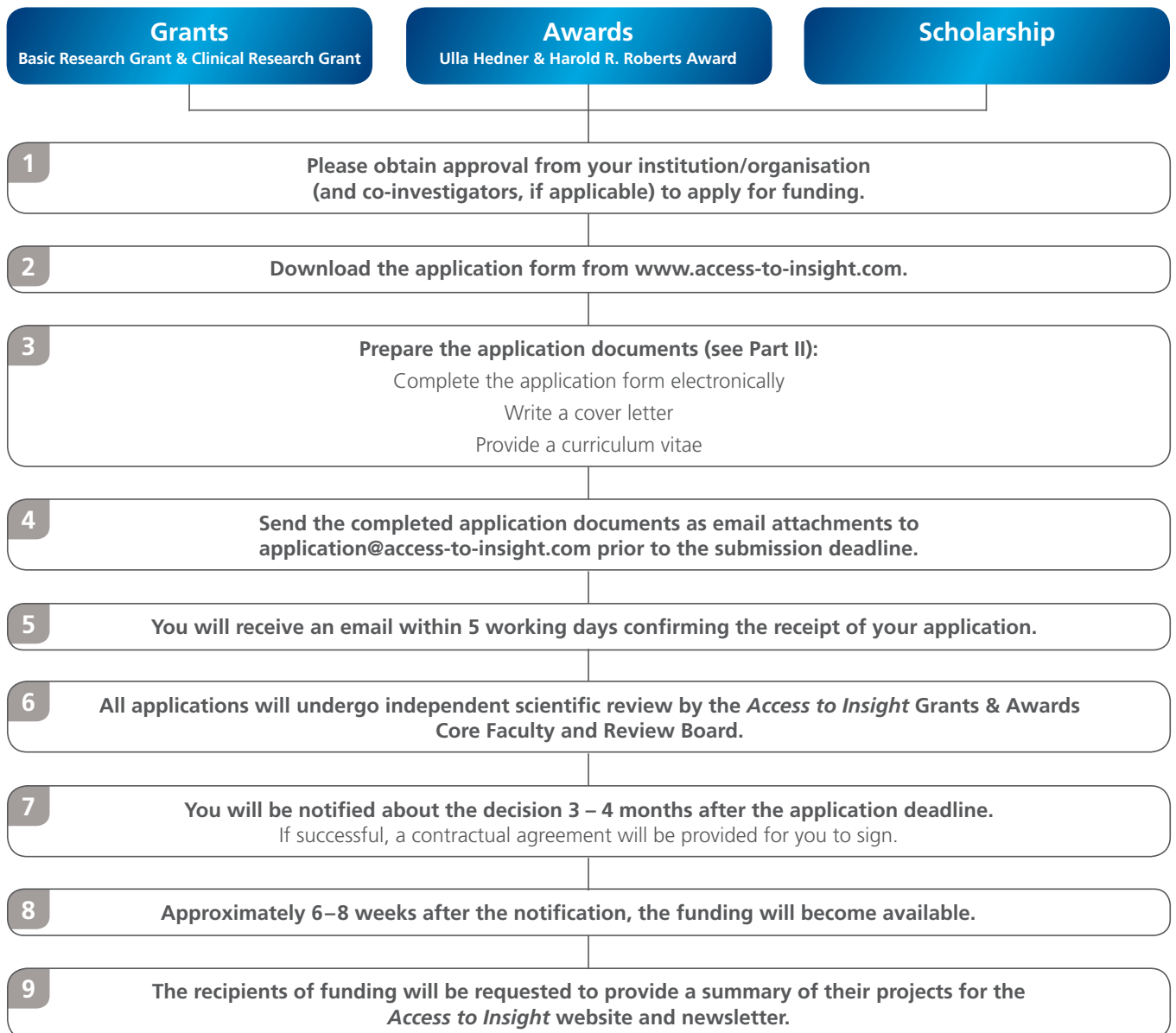

Explain the reasons for your application and describe your interest in haemostasis/haemophilia and your commitment to pursuing a career in this field.

Provide a description of past and proposed training.  Obtain permission from your preferred Haemophilia Treatment Centre before applying.
<b>Curriculum Vitae:</b> Please provide a curriculum vitae (max. 2 pages plus publication list).	List your academic degrees/positions, relevant activities. Provide a separate publication list.	List your academic degrees/positions, relevant activities, and recent publications.	List your academic degrees/positions, relevant activities, particularly all activities that have contributed to your experience in haemophilia management, and recent publications.
